

PENNDOT APPEAL INFORMATION

Any person whose license/operating privileges or vehicle registration has been denied or suspended has a right to appeal to the Court of Common Pleas in the County where the individual resides.

This appeal must be filed within **30 days** after the entry of the Department of Transportation's order, which is the date of service or the date of mailing if service is by mail. Failure to timely file an appeal deprives the Court from having subject matter jurisdiction to hear the appeal.

The filing of the appeal acts a supersedeas pending the determination of the appeal. In other words, it stays or stops the suspension until the Court makes its determination.

Upon filing an appeal, the Court is required to set a hearing on the matter. The Department of Transportation is entitled to at least **30 days** prior written notice of the hearing.

The Petitioner must serve a copy of the appeal on the Department of Transportation at the address shown on the notice Petitioner received. Service must be by **certified mail**, return receipt requested, immediately upon filing the appeal.

The Court will take testimony and examine the facts of the case at the hearing.

INSTRUCTIONS

- (1) Complete form and attach copy of notice/letter which you received from PENNDOT.
- (2) File completed form in the Prothonotary's Office on the 1st floor. There is a **filing fee \$128.00** which must be paid at the time of filing. The Prothonotary's Office will only accept *cash or money order* for payment.
- (3) Once form is filed, take paperwork to the Court Administrator's Office on the 2nd floor to have a hearing scheduled. The Court Administrator's Office will schedule a hearing on the matter and make the necessary copies for you.
- (4) You will receive a copy for yourself and a copy to serve on PENNDOT. It is your responsibility to serve the copy on PENNDOT by **certified mail**, return receipt requested, immediately upon filing the appeal.
- (5) Show up for hearing on the date scheduled.
